Playing Golf During the Coronavirus Pandemic: August 1, 2020

Information on the playability of the golf course and how the coronavirus affects us, you and business establishments changes frequently. We will do our best to update our customers on our website as changes occur from the County, State, and Federal Health Departments.

At this time a round of golf should be a safe activity if we follow some simple guidelines.

- If you or a member of your immediate family is sick, please stay home. Self-Quarantine.
- Wear your mask inside or when close proximity to others.
- Social Distance yourself from others, especially strangers.
- Reduce how often you touch public items, and reduce touching your face while increasing your hand washing and hand sanitizing.

We are taking the following steps during this time.

- **Increased Cleaning:**
 - Counters, knobs, handles will be cleaned with professional products multiple times per day
 - We have hand sanitizer on the golf shop counter and the bar top, please feel free to use it but also increase the times and length you wash your hands in the restrooms.
- **Reduced Touch Points:**
 - The golf course will not have water coolers on the course. Ballwashers are available but use at your own choice and risk.
 - Under USGA rules you can putt with the flag pole in and remove your ball without touching the flag pole. We have short pieces of foam to keep golf balls near the surface of the green. There is not a rule against removing the flag pole but it is recommended.
 - Bunker Rakes will not be available. Feel free to place the ball in a new spot if you are in a depression or footprint.
 - Condiments, napkins and other normally accessible items will be kept behind the bar, just ask for them.
- **Social Distancing:**
 - Tables and chairs in the pub and grill will be spread out.
 - Any customer can request a single cart but it is not mandatory.
 - Members and punch card holders can check in via phone, or a simple wave. Remember punch cards and memberships can be purchased from our website online store.
 - Daily Fee Players can pay via our website online store, app or via phone.

HOW TO RESERVE TEE TIMES - PAY - AND PLAY

We have rented extra carts but carts are limited so please say if you are riding when you make your tee time.

- By Phone: you can call to make tee times, check in for golf and pay for golf, carts, balls and season passes over the phone. 920-924-2424. Please be patient as these calls do take longer than just making a tee time.
- By our brand new App. You can use the app to make tee times up to 14 days in advance, check in and pay for golf or carts. The app works best one person from the group to make, check in for and pay for the rounds.
- Our Website Online Store:
 - Click on Make a Tee time to find and reserve a spot for 2, 3 or 4 golfers. Singles should call.
 - Click on the online store to pre-pay for golf, carts, pushcarts or punch cards and memberships. Please write your tee time in the notes section of your order.
 - Call or talk to the starter to check in for your round and find out what tee you are starting on.
