Although it had been extremely wet, we are thankful to be doing better than some of our neighboring courses who had serious flooding. The ponds on holes 1, 10, 18 and 27 take water from not only the golf course, but all of the businesses on the front 9 in the industrial park. With the threat of rain the past few days, we had the dam open to allow us to take some water without flooding. Luckily the rain missed us, but now the ponds are low, which is better than flooded. The next 1" rainfall will fill the ponds back up, in the meantime enjoy finding your ball on the edge of the pond.
